DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

If you were to interview five people in your neighborhood, at work, or at school, and ask, "What is life
about?" what are some answers you would most likely hear? Would their choices and use of time and
money be consistent with their answers?

What is covetousness?

What are the symptoms of materialism according to this passage? What are some ways these symptoms show up in our lives?

Why is it easy to admit that things have no lasting value but hard to stop wanting, accumulating, and getting our happiness from things?

What does it mean to be "rich toward God" (verse 21)? Is this just about money?

How can we overcome our tendency to worry about our material needs?

What does a kingdom agenda include? How can we pursue these things?
